CONSOLIDATED CARINA RESOURCES CORP. (CCK-V)

PROGRAM COMPLETED - Rick Walker, president, Consolidated Carina Resources Corp., reports field crews have completed the reconnaissance and detailed exploration program on the ROK project located in the Kinaskin Lake area east of the Stewart-Cassiar Highway about seven km from the Village of Iskut in northwestern B.C. The reconnaissance geological mapping, prospecting and contour soil/silt sampling was carried out on claims surrounding the core ROK claim. Detailed soil sampling and prospecting was done in an area to the east of the Main showing on the ROK claim. The detailed soil sampling delineated a strong gold/copper anomaly which extends 300 metres east of the North Showing. Prospecting in the vicinity of the North and East showings has returned values of up to 0.277 oz.gold/ton and 3.01% copper from grab samples of mineralized monzonite.

The IP survey over the East and North zones on the ROK claim indicates a broad, strong chargeability response characteristic of porphyry targets. Previous drilling in this area by Falconbridge was reported to have encountered significant copper values in two holes. The 1990 drilling program has begun with drill holes designed to test coincident soil geochemical and IP anomalies. Carina can earn a 50% interest in the property by spending \$400,000 over two years.
