

INTERNATIONAL KENGATE VENTURES INC. (IKV-V)
BULK SAMPLE TAKEN - Dan Clark, president, reports
International Kengate Ventures Inc.

has taken a 200-pound sample from underground on the east portion of the No.2 vein of the Rocher de Boule mine located about 60 miles northwest of Smithers, B.C. Kengate can earn a 100% interest by paying \$120,000, is using 100,000 shares and spending \$600,000 on exploration over five years, subject to a 4% net smelter return royalty. The sample will be assayed for copper, silver and gold with metallurgical testing to be conducted as well. Twenty assays from underground chip

and channel sampling on this section of the No.2 vein taken by the previous operator in 1987/88 yielded the following results:

The results from the above noted area of the No.2 vein (sub-level 1100) indicate continuation of economic mineralization below the 1002 level for 100 feet with further evidence of ore grade material down dip for 100 feet to the 1200 portal access level. Current estimated accessible reserves on the No.2 and 4 veins in the drill indicated, drift sampled and inferred categories is 137,000 tons of a 0.35 oz.gold/ton equivalent or 2.78% copper, 6.05 oz.silver/ton and 0.102 oz.gold/ton.

There are 13 vein structures identified on the Rocher de Boule property, most of which have not been explored. The majority of previous production came from the copper-rich Nos. 2 and 4 veins. Sporadically, between 1915 and 1952, there was production of 4,492 ounces of gold, 74,477 ounces of silver and 6,203,584 pounds of copper from 52,719 tons. The grade of the direct-shipping ore averaged 0.106 oz.gold/ton, 1.65 oz.silver/ton and 7.5% copper. Total ore production averaged 0.085 oz.gold/ton, 1.602 oz.silver/ton and 5.88% copper.
