Universal Trident Industries Ltd.
is planning an airborne geophysical survey to be
conducted over the 50%-owned. 252-unit Gloria claim
group located near the confluence of the Iskut and
Stikine Rivers about 110 km northwest of Stewart, B.C.
SEE MAP OVERLEAF PAGE 1. The other 50% is owned by an
affiliated private company. The property is situated
seven km west of the Eurus/Thios Rock & Roll project on
which the Black Dog volcanogenic massive sulphide
deposit is being explored.

The Gloria group covers a 16-km length of favourable sedimentary-volcanic sequence that host the Black Dog deposit and includes the Johnson Creek silver/lead/zinc occurence, which reportedly consists of vein material in a fracture zone up to 10 feet wide carrying appreciable silver/lead/zinc/copper values. An earlier government publication reports values of 10.82 oz. silver /ton, 3.43% copper, 5.04% lead and 1.47% zinc.

Universal Trident also has a 50% interest in the Doo group of 72 units which lies within and and is totally surrounded on three sides by the Rock & Roll claims. The other 50% is under option to <u>HALCYON RESOURCES LTD</u>. (HYN-V) which will be carrying out a comprehensive exploration program.
