property in the southern part of the Sheep Creek gold camp 15 km southeast of Salmo, B.C.

Ore-Hill Sumit was first staked in 1901 and had sporadic production between 1906 and 1938. The claim area is underlain by Paleozoic sedimentary rocks of the Kootney Arc and the late Mesozoic granitic rocks of Nelson Intrusives. The formation in this area contains the Reeves Limestone which has hosted several large multi-million ton lead, silver and zinc ore bodies.

Yellowjack Resources in 1990, completed an extensive work program of geological mapping, geochem survey and surface rock sampling which outlined a massive gold anomalous area of at least 1500 meters by 200 meters. Late in 1990 Yellowjack drilled three preliminary holes and visible gold was discovered in four places. Significant intersections included 0.236 oz/ton gold over 10 feet, 0.214 oz.gold/ton over 7 feet, 0.401 oz.gold/ton over 8 feet and 0.215 oz.gold/ton over 11 feet. The company feels this is likely the first gold discovery in the Reeves Limestone.
