ger Resources Inc. has received initial assays from its drill program at Chuchi Lake located about 20 miles northwest of Placer Dome's Mt. Milligan project in central B.C.

The project is 50/50 joint venture with BP Resources Canada as operator. Drilling has begun on the northeast trend established during last year's drilling.

The trend outlined by holes 90-27, 33 and 37 has been carried on by hole 91-40, which is the best hole to date on the property. Hole 90-27 cut 194 meters grading 0.21% copper and 0.21 grams gold/tonne including 70 meters grading 0.30% copper and 0.34 grams gold/tonne.

The area of ongoing drill testing is open to the north, northeast and west and covers a potential area of 1,500 by 1,000 meters which is supported by copper/gold geochemistry and induced polarization surveys.
