TREATY CREEK WORK STARTS - Murray Pezim, chairman, reports Tantalus Resources Ltd. has begun field work at the Treaty Creek project located in the Eskay Creek area about 65 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C. Tantalus can earn a 51% interest from Teuton Resources Corp. by spending \$3,200,000 on exploration and making staged cash and share payments.

Prior to diamond drilling, crews will conduct more trenching and geophysical surveys on the projected strike extent of the Mama Susu zone discovered in 1990. This zone occurs over an area about 500 by 800 meters in size and is characterized by mineralized, well altered shear zones up to 20 meters wide and numerous angular boulders of sulphide-bearing, sheared andesitic volcanics and pyroclastics with quartz veins and stockworks. Outcrop assays have returned up to 3.73% zinc, 2.86% lead, 0.11% copper and 12.90 oz.silver/ton across 3.3 feet.

More soil sampling and prospecting is planned in the area east of the Treaty Gossan zone where limited sampling in 1990 returned 0.054 and 0.038 oz.gold/ton from grab samples of Betty Creek Formation andesitic volcanics on strike with Mt. Dilworth Formation rhyolitic volcanics in contact with Salmon River Formation argillaceous sediments. It is expected drilling will start in three or four weeks.
