INITIAL SB MINING/MILLING RESULTS - Westmin Resources
Ltd. have reported

results from the initial run of ore from the SB property through the Premier mill. The project is located 20 mm north of Stewart, B.C. The project is being developed by the SB Joint Venture, with Westmin 50% and Tenajon Resources Corp. 50%. The J/V has the option of participation in Nestmin's metals marketing program and has done so to date with the forward sale of a portion of 1991 production at a price above the current gold price. A total of 7,585 dry short tons of ore mined from development headings was milled in a five-day period at a milling rate of 1,500 tons per day. Mill head grade was calculated at 0.29 oz.gold/ton. Gold recovery was 91.8% and gold production for the run totalled 2.025 troy ounces. The partners view the results as excellent. Mining and development on the SB property is continuing as planned. The next mill run is, scheduled for late August when about 20,000 tons of ore will be processed at a rate of up to 2,500 TPD. It is expected the results of the first run may be exceeded with larger throughput and minor mill adjustments. The joint venture expects to mine and mill a total of 100,000 tons of ore by year end.
