GLIDER DEVELOPMENTS INC. (GRI-V)

OUTLAW PROJECT DROPPED - Donald R.Head, director, reports

Glider Developments Inc. has received assays from two drill holes completed on the Outlaw property located in the Trapper Lake area of northwest B.C. about 80 km northwest of Telegraph Creek. Glider has an option to earn a 50% interest from

CONSOLIDATED PARKLANE RESOURCES INC. (PK-V). The diamond drilling tested an area of high gold-in-soil geochemical anomalies and gossanous rock outcropping situated in the central portion of a 1,990-meter long by 400-meter wide multi-element soil anomaly. Hole one return no significant values. Hole two returned anomalous gold values throughout its 106-meter length including 0.033 oz/t over 6 meters, 0.021 oz/t over 6 meters and 0.014 oz/t over 5 meters. Glider directors approved terminating work on the claims and will now concentrate on developing plans for its six real estate projects in Pemberton, B.C.
