The discovertes on holes $14-906$ and 907 are now thought to be separate from Gap zone ore and are probably part of new, flat-lying, $H-K$ style lenses. This lens has tentatively been named the Battle zone. Westmin continues drilling in the Gap-Battle area with three machines on a single shift basis. Westmin has received government approval for a 16-hole surface diamond drilling program to test the eastern extensions of the $\mathrm{H}-\mathrm{W}$ ore zones.
