PACIFIC RIM MINING CORP. (PRG-V)

ASSAYS AWAITED - Frank P. Kelly, president of Pacific Rim Mining has reported on the Snow Creek property, located southwest of Smithers, 4 holes have been drilled in three separate areas. The first two holes were targeted on a chargeability high and significant rock assay results located in the main creek. SC901-01 intersected 6 m of up to 10% disseminated and stockwork pyrite, chalcoprite, sphalerite and galena between 106 and 112 m and hosted by maroon volcanics. In the upper part of the hole more than four intervals of fault-related, fracture controlled, 0.1 to 1% pyrite occurs in coarse-grained feldspar porphyry. The second hole, 150 m south, intersected similar geology.
