MERRY WIDOW DRILLING COMPLETED - J. Donald Graham,
president, Taywin

Resources Ltd., reports NORANDA INC. has completed six diamond drill holes totalling 1,900 feet on the Merry Widow property located near Port McNeill, northern Vancouver Island, B.C. Noranda can earn a 51% interest by paying \$225,000 and spending \$1,500,000 within two years. The drilling was designed to test several strong geophysical anomalies along 6,270 feet of the favourable Bonanza Group rock formation. The known gold/copper mineralization in the Merry Widow pit, drilled earlier by Taywin, was not further explored in this program.

All but one of the above anomalies were drilled. The untested area is marked by strong induced polarization and magnetic readings supported by gold soil geochemical responses. Due to harsh winter conditions, the drill could not be brought to the site; this anomaly will be drilled in the spring.

Noranda's drilling in the Raven zone returned the following results:

In addition to encouraging drill results from the mine area, several chip sampling programs returned values as high as 0.30 oz.gold/ton and over 1% copper along 50 feet of pit wall. The study will determine the amount of in-fill drilling required to prove up reserves in the pit and the underground sections and also indicate possible mining methods and costs.
