ROSSLAND DRILL RESULTS - Dal S. Brynelsen, president, reports Antelope Resources Inc.

and 50/50 joint venture partner BRYNDEN YENTURES INC. (BNV-T.Alberta) has received drill results from the 1990 Rossland, B.C. Southbelt drilling program. Drill holes 90-2.3 and 4 were widespread exploratory holes targeted on the polymetallic Bluebird/Mayflower zone and show the continuity of the mineralized structure at depth and along strike. Hole 90-3 with 12.5 feet of 0.33 oz. gold/ton demonstrates the gold potential of the Bluebird zone at depth. Drill holes 90-5.6 and 7 intersedcted the Maid of Erin gold zone (formerly the New North zone), and show the continuity of gold mineralization at intermediate depths.
