Goldpac Investments Ltd. has
received assays from a trenching program on the Lookout
property located southwest of Cranbrook, B.C. The work
defined a large zone of gold mineralization in altered
quartz monzonite and Aldridge sediments along the
Cranbrook fault. The geologic environment is similar to
the Beartrack deposit near Salmon, Idaho. The Lookout
trenches tested a 525-foot strike length along the
Cranbrook fault. Assays from chip samples are below.
