B.C., an exploration program has been completed that Included geological mapping, soil, silt and rock sampling and diamond drill core resampling. Three targets were defined: 1) an annular porphyry copper/molybdenum deposit with a mineralized "shell" of about 900 meters diameter. In 1981, diamond drill hole 81-2, "shell", vertically within the copper drilled intersected 947 feet grading 0.28% copper and 0.02% molybdenum, 2) 600 meters west of the Cu-Mo deposit is a large coincident molybdenum/tungsten/gold soil anomaly, and 3) 800 meters southwest of the porphyry Cu-Mo deposit is a 30 by 150-meter gossan anomalous in copper, zinc, silver and gold.

The report recommends a \$190,000 geochemical and geophysical program; and if successful, a further \$500,000 diamond drill program. The work will be designed to define the Cu-Mo deposit and also identify peripheral precious metals. The recommendation will be considered in spring 1991 as well as possibly joint <u>venturing the project</u>.
