LAKEWATER DRILLING RESUMED - Murray Pezim, chairman,
Tymar Resources Inc.,

reports drilling has resumed on the Lakewater property located five km southwest of the Eskay Creek 21 zone deposit 60 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C. The project is an equal joint venture between Tymar, Akiko-Lori Gold Resources Ltd. and Varitech Resources Ltd.

Diamond drill holes LW90-10 and 13, completed on sections 14+25S and 15+00S respectively, returned no anomalous gold, silver or base metals results. None of the holes have tested the northern extension of the Lulu zone mineralization where it is postulated to cross the Southern and Northern claim gaps of the Lakewater property. A rhyolite-bounded argillite unit, similar to that hosting the Lulu zone mineralization, transects the Southern SIB claim gap over a strike length of 250 meters and is associated with VLF, IP and multi-element geochemical anomalies. A similar argillite horizon has yet to be tested on Sections 15+00S and 16+00S within the Northern SIB claim gap. Drill holes LW90-10 and 11 were in-fill holes between LW90-1 and 2 to complete the stratigraphic section across the North SIB claim gap. Holes LW90-12, 13 and 14 tested coincident geophysical and geochemical targets also within the North SIB claim gap. (SEE GCNL No.230, 28Nov90, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS DATA)
