INTERNATIONAL TOWER HILL MINES LTD. (ITH-V)

WORK PREPARATIONS IN PROGRESS - Norman Bonin, director,
reports International

Tower Hill Mines has retained R.T.Heard and Associates Ltd. as operator for its planned exploration program on the Siwash Creek property located at the junction of Siwash and Galena Creeks, just west of Teepee Lakes, 19 miles northeast of Princeton, B.C.

Tower Hill has an option to earn a 100% interest in the Siwash Creek properties by paying \$190,000 in cash and shares over 12 years to Oct.3, 2003. BRENDA MINES LTD. (BND-V,T) has a right to negotiate an interest in a portion of the property after payout.

Two additional showings were recently discovered containing pyrite, chalcopyrite, sphalerite and galena.

These finds extend the area of known mineralization located within the same favourable quartz porphyry host rocks for some 1,500 feet to the northwest.

A camp area has been selected and final arrangements are being made for a 10 to 12-man camp. In the next few days, a program of geological mapping, trenching and sampling will start. Six portals of the old underground workings will be opened for mapping and sampling. Following the sampling program, a 10,000-foot diamond drilling program will begin by the end of July.
