ALPINE EXPLORATION CORP. (AXC-V)

SUMMER PROGRAM UNDERWAY - Willis W. Osborne, president, reports Alpine Exploration has begun 1991 exploration of rock geochemistry and prospecting on the 140-unit Troitsa Peak gold/silver property 130 km south of Smithers, B.C. Alpine has a 100% interest in all the claims, except for three which are under option from T.A. Richards who retains a 5% NPI. The Cummins Creek system, one of eight separate areas of float and in-situ mineralization, appears to be a coherent zone as much as five km long and maybe one km wide, trending approximately east-west. Within this zone are numerous quartz veins and float trains of quartz, suggesting veins at high angles to the trend. Some grab samples of float yielded high assays, the best being 1.35 oz.gold/ton and 295 oz.silver/ton. Grab samples from veins range up to 0.127 oz.gold/ton and 76.1 oz.silver/ton.
