Stomalies greater than 10,000 parts per million in the Nubb Creek drainage and a host block with a time marker back indicating the block could be only 1,200 feet above the time of the Sullivan ore deposition. Gold veins exist throughout the property in small systems with several grab and channel samples exceeding 4.0 oz.gold/t.

During an 8,400-foot drill program, mineralization was intersected that returned 1.4% copper over 4.1 meters and 0.5% copper over 40 and 22 meters. Gold values as high as 0.3 oz./ton occurred in zones up to 30 mm. This section still requires extensive testing. An immediate work program is being planned.
