Armeno has hired Hi-Tec Resource Management Ltd. to conduct to do an exploration program on the 100%-owned Standard Creek property along the southern boundary of the Bridge River gold camp, Bralorne, B.C. Phase I, comprising geophysical surveys is now underway with Phase II, consisting mostly of diamond drilling, scheduled for mid-January. This work will concentrate

on the Piebiter zone.

The 171-claim property covering 25.5 sq. km. lies along the SE extension of a major gold-bearing structure, the Cadwallader Break of the Bralorne fault system which hosts the Bralorne/Pioneer mining complex 13 km to the NW. Previously, Armeno conducted programs that included geological mapping, geophysical surveys, geochemical rock and soil sampling and diamond drilling. In the Piebiter zone, gold mineralization appears to be concentrated at and near contacts with ultramafic rocks locally anomalous in gold. In the Chopper vein area, possible shoots containing ore-grade silver mineralization occur within a mineralized quartz vein extending two km within the property with shoot thickness up to 5.0 meters.
