EXPLORATION RECOMMENDED - Howard G. Anderson, director,

reports Toodoggone Gold Inc. has received a recommendation for a major diamond drill program totalling \$660,000 from Harold Jones, P.Eng., on the Dora, Peewee and Club claims in the Lac La Hache area, south of Williams Lake, B.C. Toodoggone Gold is in the process of acquiring Peach Lake Resources, owner of the claims.

The project is located in the Quesnel Trough and is underlain by Nicola Group volcaniclastic and sedimentary rocks intruded by a system of alkalic plutonic rocks.

Work by Amax Exploration from 1971 - 1973 include an estimation of reserves in the north zone of 1,500,000 tons averaging 0.54% copper, 0.01 oz.gold/ton and 0.10 oz.silver/ton. A vertical hole in this zone returned 140 feet grading 1.63% copper with sections up to 0.024 oz.gold/ton. Craigmont Mines drilled a cross section hole about 200 feet away that returned 20 feet grading 2.47% copper.

The South zone was tested with several widely-spaced percussion and diamond drill holes. It is a shallow fault zone about 245 meters long, 300 meters wide and 60 meters thick. Several holes returned 30 to 40 feet grading 0.30% to 0.40% copper. Four holes returned over 100 feet of 0.12% to 0.22% copper. Geochemical exploration by Peach lake identified several other areas of strong copper/gold soil values which have yet to be investigated. (SEE GCNL No. 196, OCT.12/89, P.2 FOR EARLIER INFORMATION)
