EXPLORATION PLANNED - O. Hrkac, director, reports Bellex Mining Corp. has announced its 1990 work program on the 100%-owned Jack Wilson Creek project in the Galore Creek gold camp, 150 miles north of Stewart, B.C. A \$750,000 work program is scheduled to begin 1May90 that will comprise grid extension, soil and rock geochemistry, induced polarization, magnetometer and VLF surveys and diamond drilling.

Exploration to date has outlined a 1.5 by 0.5 km copper/gold soil geochemical anomaly in the North Fork area that remains open to the north, south and east. Superimposed on this area is an aeromagnetic and IP anomaly. On the western extent of the geochemical anomaly, a 30-meter trench within a mineralized volcanic unit has yielded a weighted average of 1-meter panel samples grading 1.16% copper and 0.02 oz.gold/ton.
