WILLIAM LAKE GOLD PROSPECT TO BE DRILLED - Northair Mines has completed

a first stage exploration program at the Skinner property, located 100 miles southwest of Williams Lake, B.C. Northair can earn a 50% interest in the property. Initial prospecting had discovered a diorite hosted, fault controlled quartz vein system carrying significant gold values and subsequet hand trenching had exposed this system along 360 feet of strike length. In the recently completed program, Northair

conducted mapping and soil sampling over the entire property, coupled with a machine trenching program covering 200 of the 360 feet of known strike length. This trenching returned an average grade_of_0.863_oz. gold/ton over an average width of 3.5 feet, or 0.585 oz.gold/ton diluted to a 5.0 foot width.

Soil sampling has verified the known 360 foot strike and has also identified similar mineralization approximately 1000 feet along strike from the discovery area. A surface diamond drill program to test the vein system at depth has been recommended and will be conducted later in this season. This follow-up drill program will be the first drilling ever conducted on the property.
