SNIPPAKER EXPLORATION RESUMED - Ronald K. Metolitzky, director, reports Solomon Resources Ltd. and Winslow Gold Corp. have resumed exploration on the Snippaker Mountain project adjoining the Cominco/Prime SNIP mine in the Iskut River area some 100 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C. On 24May91, a revised option agreement was executed whereby Solomon can earn a 25% interest by issuing 50,000 shares to Winslow and spending \$1,150,000 on exploration by 31Dec92. Solomon can earn up to a 50% interest by spending an additional \$650,000 by 31Dec93. To date, Solomon has spent \$550,000.

The 1990 program identified 28 new gold/silver occurrences discovered in 1990 on the north-facing slopes of Snippaker Ridge which returned values in grab samples that included 0.540 oz.gold/ton, 29.72 oz.silver/ton, 10.10% lead, 25.40% zinc; and 0.424 oz.gold/ton, 6.59 oz.silver/ton, 4.76% lead and 1.33% zinc. The 1991 program will examine these showings on the north-facing slopes; follow-up work will include prospecting and trenching to define drill targets. Diamond drilling has now started on the south slope with a planned 900 meters in nine holes. (SEE GCNL No.68, 9Apr91, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION AND MAP OVERLEAF PAGE 2.)
