DELLATERRA RESOURCES LTD. (DEL-V)

POP NO.1 CLAIM ACQUIRED - Bassam Nastat, director,  
reports Dellaterra Resources  
Ltd. has agreed to acquire the Pop No.1 claim, located  
near the Bridal Falls-Cheam Peak area, 70 miles east of  
Vancouver, B.C. by issuing 100,000 shares. The claim  
was located to cover a favourable geological environment  
comprising a hornfelsed and skarnified Permian limestone  
intruded by granodiorite. Early exploration revealed  
quartz veins up to 7.0 feet wide containing chalcopyrite  
and pyrrhotite mineralization associated with  
calc-silicate alteration. Low grade gold-bearing  
arsenopyrite float was previously discovered on the  
claim and stream sediment samples collected were  
anomalous in arsenic and as high as 950 parts per  
billion gold.

Further exploration of the claim will consist of  
geochemical and geophysical tests along control lines  
above and lateral to the anomalous zones indicated to  
date. The initial stage of the proposed program will  
cost about \$35,000, and if positive, will be followed by  
shallow trenching and exploratory drilling. (SEE GCNL
