### WIND RIVER RESOURCES LTD. (WID-V)

GRAPHITE METALLURGY ENCOURAGING - Ted Yardley, director reports Wind River Resources Ltd. has received encouraging results from exploration on the graphite AA1-22 claim group located on South Bentinck Arm about 30 km south of Bella Coola, B.C. The company can earn a 100% interest on undisclosed terms. First phase exploration comprised mapping, sampling and drilling of two known graphite occurrences. Initial testing and metallurgical evaluation of one 34-foot wide vein containing about 20% carbon was viewed as encouraging. Consultants Bacon Donaldson & Associates Ltd. report the first test showed the ore is relatively soft with flotation recoveries high. The low grade of the concentrate is a concern, but it is believed with some modifications to the procedure, a high grade product can be achieved. Bacon Donaldson have recommended a petrographic study of polished thin sections. Work will start immediately to test a gold occurrence in quartz veins associated with and adjacent to the graphitic structure. (SEE GCNL No.70, 11Apr91, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
