PACIFIC RIM MINING CORP. (PFG-V)

**SNOW CLAIMS DRILLING PLANNED - Frank Kelly, president,
reports Pacific Rim**

**Mining Corp. plans to start drilling on the 100%-owned
Snow claims 25 miles SW of Smithers, B.C. In Oct/89 the**

company completed an IP survey on the central portion of the Snow Creek area revealing an anomaly 985 by 328 feet in size open in both directions. Earlier work indicated another 656 feet, giving an overall length exceeding 1,600 feet. Grab samples have returned assays as high as 1.89 oz.gold/ton and 7.5 oz.silver/ ton. A float sample assayed 5.21 oz.gold/ton and 67.54 oz. silver /ton. Chip sampling across available outcrop has returned 0.47 oz.gold/ton and 6.8 oz.silver/ton. Pacific Rim management believe the property has the potential to host a volcanogenic massive sulphide deposit. Several major mining companies have approached Pacific Rim to discuss possible joint ventures. The claims lie within six miles of an all-weather road.
