WISEBOY RESOURCES INC. (BOY-V)

HELEN CLAIMS ACQUIRED - Bing Jung, president, reports
Wise Boy Resources Inc. has
acquired the Helen claims, on undisclosed terms,
comprising 52 units covering 3,212 acres located 20 km
south of the Eurus/Thios Rock & Roll project in the
Iskut River area some 100 km northwest of Stewart, B.C.

The Helen property is predominantly underlain by Triassic and Jurassic sedimentary rocks, similar to those hosting the Black Dog deposit on the Rock & Roll project. Regional work by government geologists show stream sediments from the property are anomalous in gold, copper and arsenic. The local bedrock is sericite, a favourable rock type for both massive sulphide and gold deposits. Limited preliminary exploration of the Helen property area in 1987 documents two samples of silicified and chloritized sedimentary rocks from the western part of the property returned 220 and 780 parts per billion gold. In addition, the northeast corner of the property was found to host two more areas of interest, one with gold values as high as 330 ppb over a 400-meter distance in a creek bed. The second area, a ridge some 200 meters from the creek, was sampled at 25-meter intervals and returned gold values up to 320 ppb. Both of these zones were noted to lie on the same trend parallel to the strong shearing throughout the property. An work program is planned for summer. (SEE GCNL No.64, 3Apr91, P.7 FOR OTHER DATA)
