SENECA DRILL PROGRAM RESUMED - International Curator Resources Ltd. has

reported Minnova Inc. has started a 3,200 foot diamond drilling program on the Seneca Massive sulphide property located 100 km east of Vancouver, B.C. just west of Harrison Lake on a part of the Agassiz-Weaver property.

The drilling will test for extensions to the northwest and southeast of the Fleetwood Zone discovered during Minnova's summer drilling program and has been tested on broadly spaced 650 foot centers. It has been intersected by three diamond drill holes over a strike length of 1,600 feet. The three massive sulphide intercepts average 7.65% zinc, 0.52% copper, 0.84% lead, 2.49 oz.silver/ton and 0.03 oz.gold/ton over 6 feet.

Minnova can earn a 51% interest by spending \$1,600,000 on exploration and making cash payments of \$300,000 by 1996. Minnova can earn a further 9% by spending an additional \$500,000 by 1998 with Curator to retain the residual interest of 49% or 40%.
