APEX MOUNTAIN DRILL RESULTS - Thomas Kirk, president, reports Kilo Gold Mines Ltd. has received drill results from its Apex Mountain property located 26 km southwest of Penticton and about six miles west of the Nickel Plate mine near Hedley, B.C. Six AW diamond drill holes totalling 451 feet have been completed averaging 72 feet deep. See table above. Holes 91-5 and 91-6 returned no significant results. The holes were drilled to test the down-dip projection of a sulphide skarn zone exposed along a 50-meter strike length excavated during the 1950's. Previous sampling returned 1.14 oz.gold/ton over a 4-meter thickness and 0.8 oz.gold/ton over 3.0 meters. Check samples taken in 1988 returned similar values. Two additional zones, 80 meters and 120 meters east of the trenches and along the marble trend of the skarn zone, returned assays of 0.78 oz.gold/ton over 1.0 meters and 0.43 oz.gold/ton over 5.0 meters in a sulphide-rich skarn zone.

Elsewhere on the 1,400-hectre property, 10 other geophysical/geochemical targets remain to be tested. Kilo is searching for a previous drill hole that reportedly returned 0.2 oz.gold/ton over 40 feet. (SEE GCNL No.177, 13Sep91, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
