YELLOWJACK RESOURCES LTD. (YJK-V)

OPTION DISPUTE RESOLVED - Douglas F. Collingwood, president, reports Bakra Resources and Yellowjack Resources Ltd. have resolved their dispute regarding the Sumit-Ore Hill property near Salmo, B.C. The option granted by Yellowjack for Bakra to earn a 50% interest has been reinstated.

Assays from recent drilling confirmed the presence of a massive sulphide zone. This mineralization occurs to the north and topographically below the gold veins mined in the reeves limestones. Eight holes were drilled with four intersecting significant values below:

The companies speculate the zone will widen with depth as the intrusive contact is approached. Hydrothermal alteration in the drill core appears to be increasing with depth and to the south into the hillside. The next drilling phase, now under consideration, will be targeted deeper.
