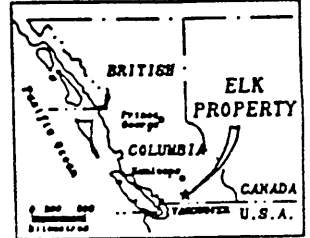
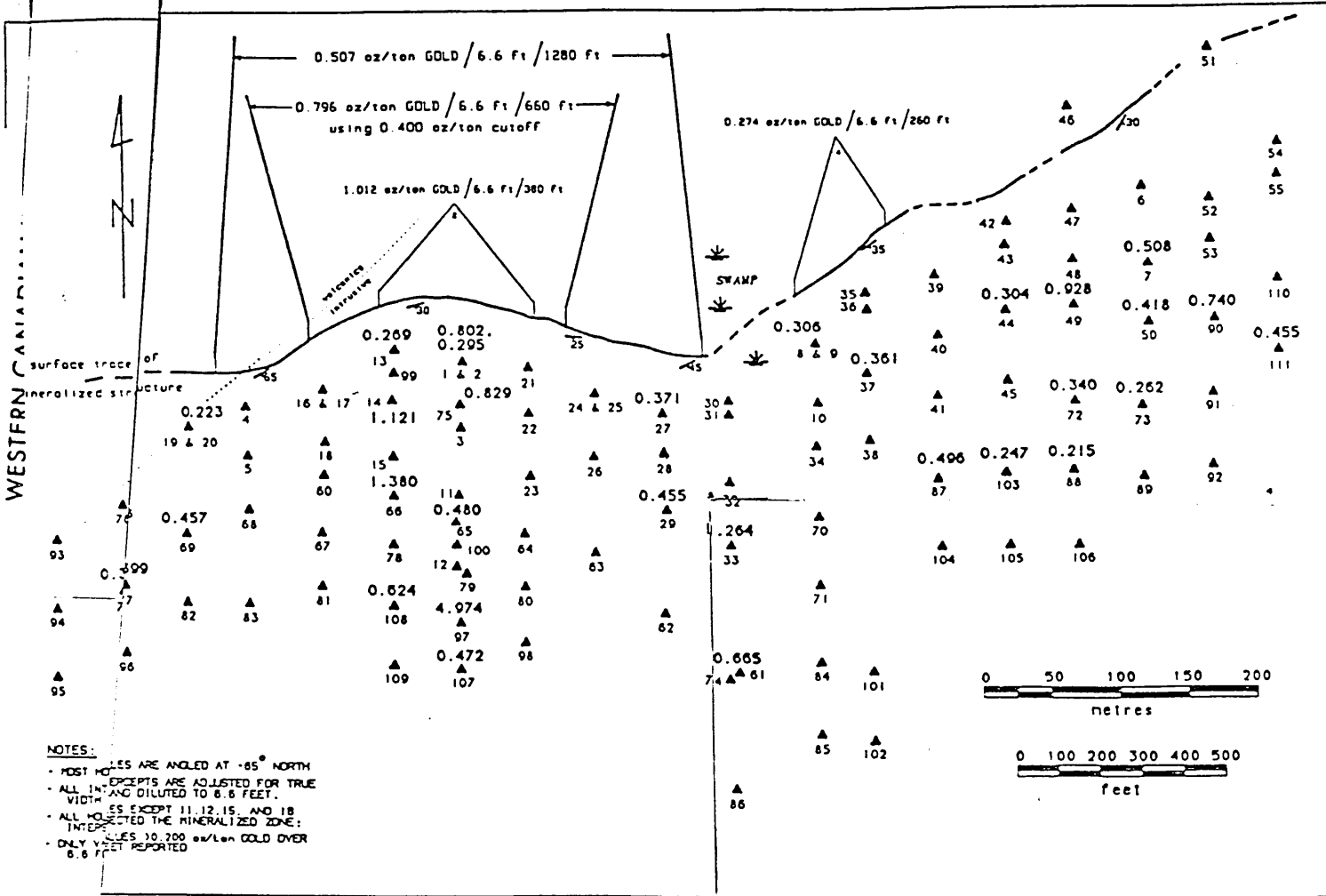
A total of 107 holes have been drilled at Siwash North since 1989, of which 29%, of 31 holes have returned fully diluted assays over 6.6 ft. true width greater than 0.20 oz. gold/t and 24%, 26 holes, greater than 0.30 oz. gold per ton.

Drilling has traced the gold bearing system along a strike length of 3,000 feet to a depth of 1,000 feet down dip and indicates at least five high grade gold shoots exist. The system remains open to expansion along strike and down dip.
