LA ROCK MINING CORP. (LAR-V)

BRANDYWINE DRILL PROGRAM PLANNED - Martial Levasseur, president has reported La Rock Mining has discovered a new zone on the south end of the Brandywine property, 30 miles north of Squamish, B.C. A grab sample assayed 0.726 oz gold/t, 2.07 oz silver/t, 1.93% lead, 3.94% zinc. Stripping of this zone is planned.

The company is planning a drilling program in November on the north end of the property at the Tedi pit where previous diamond drilling was done. Three old holes in this area have, for 20 and 30 ft. widths, intercepted average values of 0.06 oz. gold/t, 8.65 oz. silver/t, 4.25% copper, 11.3% lead, 13.25% zinc.

In 1968, the previous owner shipped 365 tons from the Tedi pit direct to the smelter. Averages for this shipment were as follows: 0.12 oz. gold/t, 9.50 oz. silver/t, 5.28% copper, 15.0% lead, 12.5% zinc.

In September, 1991, Fox Geological Consultants examined the company's property and took 2 samples of the Tedi Pit zones with the following results:
