LIBERTY GOLD CORP. (LGP-V)

NATIVE COPPER DISCOVERED - Glen E. White, president, reports Liberty Gold Corp. has discovered a zone of native copper on the 100%-owned Lac La Hache property located in the Cariboo region of central B.C. The company completed a minor amount of road work and drill site preparation in readiness for a fall diamond drill program. During the work, visible native copper, chalcopryite and chalcocite were uncovered along the eastern induced polarization anomaly over a length of about 700 meters. The 1990 drilling in the East zone returned 135 feet grading 0.40% copper, 170 feet of 0.25% copper with sporadic gold ranging up to 0.02 oz/ton. Liberty is presently discussing a debt settlement and a private placement. (SEE GCNL No.174,
