modest program of geophysical surveys, prospecting, trenching, sampling and limited geological mapping was completed in 1991 by Teuton Resources on the 100% owned Tennyson claims, 4 miles west of the Granduc mining road, about 30 miles north of

Stewart, B.C.

From 1986 to 1990, the property was explored by 17 diamond drill holes on vein-type targets, certain of which carried high grade gold. Few of the samples were assayed for copper. It was decided to re-evaluate the property as a potential copper-gold porphyry target. A trench to test pronounced malachite staining. The weighted average grade of 9 continuous chip samples taken along a combined length of 85 ft. came to 0.017 oz/ton gold and 0.35% copper. Similar malachite staining has been observed in previous work programs at many places along the 2,500 by 1600 ft. exposure of the alteration zone.

Also during the 1991 program several new quartz veins were discovered on the western margin of the alteration zone. Grab samples from these veins assayed 2.23 oz/ton gold, 29.11 oz/ton silver. High-grade float boulders from undetermined sources were also located.

A follow-up 1992 program will include drill testing of the copper-gold mineralization.
