QC DRILL RESULTS - Ronald K. Netolitzky, director,

Dryden Resources Corp., reports a five-hole, 721.9-meter drill program has been completed on the QC property, in the Quash Creek area about 40 km southwest of the Village of Iskut, B.C. SEE MAP OVERLEAF PAGE 2. Dryden is earning a 50% interest in the property from Teck Corporation/Triumph Resources Ltd./Silver Standard Resources Inc. by paying \$50,000, issuing 100,000 shares and spending \$1,000,000 on exploration. Upon exercising the option, Teck will hold the remaining 50% interest in the property with Triumph holding a 9% net profits royalty and Silver Standard a 1% net profits royalty. Two drill holes totalling 174.7 meters tested the upper Gordon gold quartz vein system which has been traced in outcrop for 70 metres, and can be projected by soil geochemistry over a distance of 300 metres. The holes tested the zone 50-meter spacings.

Three holes totalling 547.2 meters were drilled in a north-south fence to test across the northern margin of a large porphyry copper/gold system outlined by previous field programs. Anomalous soil geochemical values in copper and gold, along with geological mapping have outlined a target measuring 1,700 metres long by up to 900 metres wide, and exposed over a vertical distance of 350 metres. The three holes are located along a section line where two holes were completed by Amoco in 1970. (SEE GCNL No.169, 3Sep91, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS DATA)

CROESUS RESOURCES INC. (CNV-V)

ENCOURAGING FIELD RESULTS - Corwin E. Coe, director, reports Croesus Resources has recently completed the 1991 field program on the 100% owned Nutt and Dad properties located in the North Iskut region of northwest B.C. Croesus carried out a program of prospecting, mapping and heavy sediment sampling. Encouraging results were obtained from a chalcedony breccia zone on the northeast portion of the claim block. A one-meter chip sample assayed 860 parts per billion gold within a zone that was traced for 25 meters along strike.
