MORE SENECA DRILLING PLANNED - Rick Bailes, vice president, International

Curator Resources Ltd., reports Minnova Inc. will carry out additional diamond drilling on the newly discovered Fleetwood massive sulphide zone on the Seneca property located 100 km east of Vancouver, B.C. Minnova can earn a 51% interest by spending \$1,600,000 on exploration and making cash payments of \$300,000 by 1996. Minnova can earn a further 9% by spending an additional \$500,000 by 1998 with Curator to retain the residual interest of 49% or 40%. This program will start in early November and will consist of 1,000 meters of drilling to test extensions of the Fleetwood zone which is open to the northwest, southeast and south.

The Fleetwood zone has been tested on broadly-spaced 200-meter centres and has been intersected by three diamond drill holes over a strike length of 500 meters. The three massive sulphide intercepts average 7.65% zinc, 0.52% copper, 0.894% lead, 2.49 oz.silver/ton and 0.03 oz.gold/ton over 1.83 meters. The Fleetwood zone is underlain by strong stockwork mineralization comprising interlaced (anastomosing) veinlets of chalcopyrite and sphalerite in a silicified and sodium-depleted rhyolite flow, indicating a strong metaliferous, hydrothermal system was active during volcanic deposition.
