VANCOUVER ISLAND COPPER DISCOVERY - Robert A. Evans,

Resources Ltd., reports preliminary exploration has discovered copper mineralization on the Le Mare claims located south of Quatsino Sound on the west coast of northern Vancouver Island, B.C., about 20 air miles west of the Island copper/gold/molybdenum mine.

About \$400,000 has been spent on exploration since the project began last March. The work was designed to explore for porphyry copper/gold/moly deposits similar to Island Copper. Four claim groups comprising a total of 570 units were staked with preliminary prospecting, geochemistry and geological mapping completed on each group. Based on encouraging preliminary results, detailed follow-up work was conducted on the Le Mare claims where a five-km mineralized trend was established which hosts porphyry-style mineralization in several outcrops on the western portion of the claims (Culleet Creek) and a major alteration cap on the southeast portion of the property, the South Gossan zone.

Preliminary representative sampling of road borrow pits returned values up to 0.49% copper on the Culleet Creek zone. Results are pending from detailed continuous chip sampling from hand-blasted trenching which tested several showings over a 500 by 750-meter area. On the South Gossan zone, soil sampling returned results up to 2,307 parts per million copper, 25 ppm molybdenum and 1,417 parts per billion gold.
