## COMMONWEALTH GOLD CORP. (CWC-V)

WATSON BAR WORK STARTS - D.Bruce Horton, director, reports Commonwealth Gold Corp. has begun a \$400,000 exploration program on the Watson Bar project located 15 km southeast of the Blackdome mine and 75 km north of Lillooet, B.C. The work will include further soil and rock geochemical surveys, backhoe trenching and 7,500 feet of diamond drilling in 10 to 15 holes. Commonwealth is earning 50% of Cyprus Canada Inc.'s interest by spending \$1,100,000 on exploration. Previously, Cyprus drilling returned 0.58 oz.gold/ton over 16.4 feet, 0.047 oz.gold/ton over 59 feet and 0.21 oz.gold/ton over 13 feet. (SEE GCNL No.175, 11Sep91, P.3 FOR OTHER INFORMATION)
