DIGGER RESOURCES INC. (DIG-V)

CHUCHI LAKE DRILL RESULTS - Bill Scott, director, Digger Resources Inc., reports an additional high grade zone has been discovered at Chuchi Lake in north-central B.C. about 20 miles northwest of Placer Dome's Mt. Milligan deposits. The Chuchi Lake project is a 50/50 joint venture with BP Resources Canada as operator. The high grade of this zone coupled with the nature of the mineralization and alteration has required a follow-up drilling program to be started immediately. A six-hole program is underway to establish further depth and width to this zone. All initial holes drilled in this program have intersected this pyrrhotite-rich zone and assays are currently awaited.

Assays are also awaited for hole 91-60 which is the follow-up hole to the initial high grade intersection defined by hole 91-42, which was drilled to a depth of 320.6 meters and was generally mineralized throughout. The results are as outlined below:
