MM100 DRILLING TO START - Douglas McRae, director, reports drilling will resume on Sept. 16 at its 100%-owned MM100 project located near Stewart, B.C. Additional new surface exploration results including an induced polarization survey indicate the first series of holes skirted a significant target on the Hilltop zone. A new series of holes will test the recently defined target to the south and west of the previous program. The September program will test to a depth between 200 and 300 meters as IP results indicate higher metal concentrations at depths greater than the 100-meter depth drilled in the first program.

The initial seven holes on the Hilltop zone all encountered mineralization throughout the core and ICP assays returned highly anomalous gold values in the system. Follow-up fire assays of eight, 1.5-meter sections of the first hole returned values between 0.025

and 0.077 oz.gold/ton. Two further core pulp samples fire assayed at 0.307 and 0.054 oz.gold/ton.

A surface exploration crew is currently on KRL's Sea 1-4 claim block located in the Tulsequah region of the Stikine Arch, northwest B.C. (SEE GCNL No.158, 16Aug91, P.3 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
