### GRANGES INC., (GXL-T)

UNUK DRILLING MAY CONTINUE - Colin Kaiser, president, reports Granges Inc., 50%, plans to continue drilling at the Unuk project (Coul 3 claim) in light of the encouraging assays received to date, provided partners SPRINGER RESOURCES LTD., 37.5%, and COVE RESOURCE CORP., 12.5%, agree. Full-scale drilling would continue as long as weather permits, estimated to be another month or so. Hole J-91-7 intersected 3.3 grams gold/tonne, or 0.98 oz.gold/ton, and 248 grams silver/tonne, or 7.3 oz.silver/ton over 4.0 meters in an upper zone and a lower zone grading 5.44 grams gold/tonne, or 0.16 oz.gold/ton over 2.0 meters.

The Unuk project is situated on the favourable Mt. Dilworth Formation about five km south of the Eskay Creek deposits, which are some 65 k northwest of Stewart, B.C. (SEE GCNL No.185, 25Sep91, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
