AKIKO-LORI GOLD RESOURCES LTD. (AKI-V)

NEW SULPHIDE ZONE DISCOVERED - Donald R. Sheldon, president, reports Akiko-Lori Gold Resources Ltd. has completed a reconnaissance mapping and prospecting program on the I-Horn property located 15 km southeast of Dease Lake, northwest B.C. Gold Fields Mining Corp. can earn a 50% interest by spending \$1,500,000 on exploration over five years.

Three significant zones of precious metal and polymetallic mineralization have been located for about 5.4 km along the contact between mafic volcanics and a package of felsic volcanic rocks comprised of rhyolite, breccia, dacite and monolithic brecciated tuff. Sampling within the GL polymetallic veined zone yielded up to 0.101 oz.gold/ton, 2.67% copper, 17% zinc and 4.71% lead. About 2.5 km to the east within the S zone, copper mineralization across a true width of 8.0 meters was trenching and returned 0.75% copper and 0.61 oz.silver/ton. High grade intervals present in quartz/carbonate veinlets assayed 0.088 oz.gold/ton, 14.38

oz.silver/ton and 23.3% copper. Associated quartz vein structures located near the trench contain up to 0.152 oz.gold/ton and 0.44% copper.

In a third area, 2.9 km east of the S zone, polymetallic mineralization contained in a quartz carbonate/breccia was traced for over 20 meters. Values returned were up to 3% copper, 7.86% zinc, 1.6 oz.silver/ton and 568 parts per billion gold. More work is planned. (SEE GCNL No.179, 18Sep91, P.2 FOR OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION)
