CORE DRILLING UNDERWAY - John W. Greenslade, president
AT LEXINGTON PROJECT of Britannia Gold Corp. has
reported the first of a planned
series of core drill holes on the Vacher Zone at the
Lexington property, 10 miles south of Greenwood, B.C.
intersected the mineralized zone between 86.5 feet and
116 feet, for a total intersection of 38.5 feet;
including 7 feet of heavy sulphide mineralization. This
significant intercept supports the previously untested
geologic model. The objective of this first diamond
drill phase is to develop sufficient information for a
larger scale diamond drill program. Core has been split
and sent for assaying.

Futher testing of an additional parallel zone to the south of the Yacher Zone is planned to begin within several weeks. This potential parallel zone has returned high grade mineralization in previous drilling.
