BARKHOR RESOURCES INC. (BHO-V)

MASSIVE SULPHIDE SHOWING TO BE TRENCHED - William D.

Daly, president of Chapleau Resources has reported prospecting on the Arc claims near Crawford Bay, B.C. has located a massive sulphide showing 30 feet long by 8 feet wide. Overburden covers the strike extent and true width. The sulphides consist of pyrrhotite (iron), galena (lead), sphalerite (zinc) and minor chalcopyrite (copper). A visual estimate suggests that the showing is ore grade. Trenching and sampling is planned for later this month.

Chapleau Resources Ltd. and Barkhor Resources Inc. are earning a combined 50% interest in the project by expending \$200,000 for exploration in 1992 and a further \$200,000 in 1993. Chapleau has terminated the options on the Racki and LDM claims, Buck 1 claims and Birdie claims, all located at Cranbrook, B.C.
