NEW B.C. MINERAL DISCOVERY - Donald Sheldon, president, reports Omega Gold Corp.

and optionee SCC Resources Inc. have made a new base metal discovery on the Kit property located 25 km northeast of Cranbrook in southeast B.C. SCC can earn a 50% interest by spending \$250,000 on exploration over two years. Massive lead-zinc sulphide mineralization was exposed in a hand trench put down within a 100 by 300-meter lead/zinc soil geochemical anomaly. The trench is three km south of and along strike from the stratabound Kootenay King lead/zinc/silver deposit. The mineralization is hosted within a band of sericitic and limonitic shales of the Lower Aldridge Formation, which also hosts Cominco's Sullivan mine 45 km south.

Grab samples have been collected from the trench and have been sent for assay. Additional mechanical trenching is planned across the full width of the soil anomaly.
