Westmin Resources has reported the successful intersection of the Battle zone in the Buttle Lake mine, 60 miles west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, 8.C. with drill holes on sections 16 + 92E and 13 + 72E and probably also section 15 + 85E. The latter hole intersection is not certain since it is a 104 meter long stepout to the south. Hole 14-751 is particularly significant because it is the second hole on section 13+72E and confirms the zone continues to the south. Hole 14-726 is also important because it has picked up the Battle zone again to the south of the miss on hole 14-724. New holes inclined -65° south and -58° south have been collared on sections 16-92E and 15-85E respectively. The next hole on section 13+72E is planned to be inclined at -82° south.
