PROJECT UPDATES - Westmin Resources reports holes on Section 15+85E and Section 16+92E have cut the Battle zone target horizon at the Myra Falls mine, Vancouver Island, B.C. Hole 14-912 on Section 15+85E, inclined at -57° south, cut the zone 26 meters south of 14-910, encountered 2.8 m of mineral visually estimated to contain 9% zinc, but below 1% copper. Hole 14-727, on Section 16+85E, inclined at -63° south, cut 4.3 ft. of chalcopyrite/ pyrite stringer mineral visually estimated at 2% copper and below 1% zinc. Assays will be available in a few days. Drilling is planned to test the Battle zone to the north and east.

At the Premier gold project near, Stewart, B.C., full scale operations will cease 30Jun92 and 98 employees will be laid off. The company will continue exploration in the area. (SEE GCNL No.73, 13Apr92, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
