INTERNATIONAL CURATOR RESOURCES LTD. (ICRV)
SENECA DRILL PROGRAM TO RESUME - Michael D. McInnis,
president, International
Curator Resources has reported Minnova, Inc. has started

in the Fleetwood zone.

The Fleetwood Zone has probable dimensions of 3,300 feet by 1,200 feet extending north-west from the Vent Zone. The two zones are believed to be part of the same zone. They differ in that the Vent Zone disseminated sulphides in an extensive footwall stringer zone up to 100 feet thick.

Recent promising drill results from the Fleetwood Zone include hole 91-18, completed by Minnova in November, 1991. It intersected 27.0 feet from 809.7 feet to 836.7 feet grading 5.74% zinc, 0.52% copper, 0.04% lead, 0.22 oz. silver/ton, and 0.002 oz. gold/ton; including 7.4 feet of near-massive material at the top of the zone grading 9.67% zinc and 0.79% copper.

Minnova, Inc., operator, can earn a 60% interest in the property by incurring \$2,100,000 in work expenditures and making cash payments of \$300,000 to International Curator by 1998.
