NOBLE METAL GROUP INC. (NMG-V)

LOW VALUES IN CHECK HOLES - Noble Metal Group has
TO BE FURTHER ASSAYED reported the drilling,
sampling, crushing and
assaying of 64 samples of Twin Hole 92-01 has now been
completed at the optioned property 10 miles north of
Princeton, B.C. This hole was a 12 foot step out to the
West of the Vendors' No. 7 hole. Core samples taken
were based on geology and were at one and three meter
lengths. These samples were at various intervals
throughout the hole. The results from thirty-five
samples assayed by Bacon Donaldson of Vancouver showed
very low gold, platinum group metal values.

Due to the huge differences in the assay results
obtained in hole no. 7, the company is undertaking
further tests by two Canadian assay houses and the U.S.
laboratory to clarify results. (SEE GCNL NO. 29, P. 1,
