CONSOLIDATED RAMROD GOLD CORPORATION (CYN-V,T)

LEG CLAIMS DRILLING STARTED - Karl Rollke, director,
reports Consolidated

Ramrod Gold Corp. has begun drilling on the Leg claims, comprising 40 claims about 15 km north of Creston, B.C. Ramrod owns 27 of the claims and has an option to earn a 50% interest in the 13 other claims from LEGION RESOURCES LTD. (LGN-V) by spending \$500,000 on exploration by Oct.31/92. Ramrod has spent \$250,000 on the property to date. The property covers a stratiform zinc and minor lead occurrence hosted in upper Proterozoic clastic sediments. Kokanee Explorations, now part of Ramrod, conducted a short diamond drilling program in 1990 confirming the presence of two bedded sphalerite (zinc) horizons occurring over a stratigraphic interval of 20 metres. Hole L90-1 cut both the upper zone, averaging 4.75% zinc from 74-81 metres with a 2.6 metre interval of 10.2% zinc, and the lower zone averaging 2.49% zinc from 112-117 metres. Two of three step-out holes cut the lower zone which assayed 5.5 metres at 3.6% zinc and 8.6 metres at 2.3% zinc.

Geophysics and soil geochemistry have traced the mineralized zone for a minimum of 2 km north of Hole L90-1. Ramrod's drilling program is designed to test anomalous areas in that region. (SEE GCNL No.161, 20Aug92, P.3 FOR OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION).
